Brief description of Hearings Officer role:

The role of the Hearings Officer is responsible for overseeing and managing all breaches and disciplinary as well as convene any hearings proceedings as required.

Duties:

- 1. Distribute email correspondence to individual players and/or team managers for any Code of Conduct and/or By Laws breaches.
- 2. Convene Disciplinary hearings and Judiciary Panels as required and in accordance with TFA regulations.
- 3. Keep accurate and detailed records of all past Judiciary Panel hearings and findings.
- 4. At monthly meetings, report on compliance with By Laws and Code of Conduct.
- 5. Attend committee meetings on a regular basis and attend to tasks delegated at these meetings.
- 6. Provide support, assistance and mentoring to other committee members as required.
- 7. Provide Working with Children Check details to the Member Protection Officer.
